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## Our Wines

Although bubbly is what started the adventure, Hout Bay Vineyards also produce a range of other wines which include a Sauvignon Blanc, a full-bodied red as well as a delicate light rosé.

All the grapes from Hout Bay Vineyards is exclusively used for their Cap Classique and from the second pressing a rose wine is produced. They have expanded their range to include white wines from grapes within the valley and their red wine is produced from grapes grown in the Stellenbosch region.

### METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE

**MCC 2008:** 60% Pinot Noir, 40 % Chardonnay  
Bottled in October 2008 and in the process of second fermentation

**MCC 2007:** 45% Pinot Noir, 65% Chardonnay  
Bottled in October 2008 and in the process of second fermentation

**MCC 2006:** 40% Pinot Noir, 60% Chardonnay  
Bottled October 2006, disgorged October 2008  
The bubbly fresh and fruity on the palate with lingering yeasty flavours

**MCC 2005:** NOT YET RELEASED

Maiden vintage

**MCC 2004:** **Blanc de Blanc:** A full bodied, rich though dry bubbly with distinct yeasty aftertaste. 100% Chardonnay (SOLD OUT)

**Blanc de Noir:** Chardonnay, Pinot Noir Blend.

Complex, yeasty bubbly with noticeable 'dry peach' on the palate



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### WHITE WINES



#### 2007 Sauvignon Blanc:

A 'BIG' wine full of tropical fruit flavours

#### 2008 Sauvignon Blanc:

Again, a succulent, full bodied dry white wine, with gooseberry flavours and a green edginess.



#### 2008 Blush:

Chardonnay, Pinot Noir Blend

A fruity, smooth and easy drinking, dry rose. Fresh and fruity.

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Solutions cc **2006 Bourdeaux Blend**

A blend of Cab. Franc, Cab Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Malbec gives this wine the potential to lie down for a few years, but is also delicious to drink now. A big concentration of ripe berry fruits and the slightest hint of chocolate make this a well proportioned wine
